New York State Names New Connector Road for Former Foundation Director


In 1986-1987 while stationed at Fort Drum, New York, then Brigadier General Paul G. Cerjan served as a Director of the Sacred Heart Foundation. A New York native, his service to his nation and community was recently recognized with the naming of a long awaited connector road between Interstate Route 81 and U.S. Route 11 in his honor.

The project included the construction of approximately 4.8 miles of new interstate, designated Interstate 781, between Interstate 81 and the Main Gate of Fort Drum.

The new interstate is ceremonially named after Lieutenant General Paul Cerjan, a key architect of the modern Fort Drum and a driving force behind the expansion of the

installation. A Rome, NY native, General





After his retirement in 1994, General Cerjan continued to contribute to both our nation and the North Country. He served as CEO of several organizations in direct support of soldiers in combat and also served as president of three universities.

General Cerjan died in April, 2012.
