

# Br. Pierre "Peter" Marceau, MSC January 31, 1922—September 30, 2016



Brother Pierre T. "Peter" Marceau, MSC died September 30, 2016. We celebrated Brother Peter's funeral mass on October 5, 2016. Three MSC Brothers participated in the Mass, doing readings and the Universal Prayers. There were four family members from Canada who served as pall bearers along with two parishioners from Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish. There were five or six Sisters of St. Joseph in the congregation of some 80 parishioners and friends, and ten priests concelebrating with the Very Rev. Raymond Diesbourg, MSC, Provincial Superior of the MSC in the United States. This gathering of the faithful who came to honor, to pray for and to take leave of Br. Peter, reflected what he was all about. Br. Peter spent time overseas in Colombia, helping to build a parish complex in Colombia, Latin America.

Brother Peter will rightly be remembered for the way he took to work. He lived by the rule that "a job worth doing, is worth doing well. At the same time, he worked like there was no tomorrow. However, as our Superior General in Rome, Fr. Mark

McDonald remarked in sharing condolences with our community, "Br. Peter was as dedicated to prayer as he was to work. He never missed a community mass or daily prayers and spent many an hour in Chapel as well." Br. Peter died as the oldest member of the MSC in the western hemisphere, having celebrated the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his religious profession on September 1, 2016, just 30 days before he departed from this earth. May he rest in peace and may he remember us as we do him.
